

2014 Ixtapa Sailfish Tournament Results

It's all in the Family Chris Molle becomes the 4th in the family to win Ixtapa!

Following in the footsteps of his father, grandfather and grandmother, Chris Molle captured the victory in the 2014 Ixtapa Sailfish Tournament. Chris started out strong on the first day with 4 fish released, released 1 fish on day 2, and finished strong again on day 3 with 4 releases.

This years tournament marked the return to Ixtapa after a 3 year hiatus due to poor fishing. The local boat captains were very happy to see the return of the tournament, and many of their old friends from TAA. The tournament had 30 anglers who averaged just over 1 fish per angler per day. Day one was the best day with 39 sailfish released. Danny Brooks, Judy Franich, Ray Jones and Richard Schwager each had 3 releases on the first day. Day 2 was the slowest with 23 sailfish released. Steve Davis, Bill Evans and Jerry Yahiro each had 3 releases on day 2. On day 3 the fishing improved slightly with 34 sailfish released. Dale Miles and Jerry Yahiro each had 3 fish released.
