2007 IXTAPA SAILFISH TOURNAMENT

The 16th annual Ixtapa Sailfish Tournament was held January 13 to 20, 2007. Fifty anglers left the pier in Zihuatanejo, on Monday morning with high hopes.

Judy Franich was the first to hook up and tip a sailfish. Only 7 other sailfish were caught that first day. John Jackson managed to hook and tip 2 sails. John also ended as high point angler for day 1. Steve Lynch tipped the last fish of the day.

Day 2 started with Richard Ziegler tipping the first sail. The day ended with a three-way tie for first place with John Jackson, Judy Franich (1, plus 1 on day 1) and Alan Molle (2). Richard Ziegler ended as high point angler with 150 points. Rod Van Saun caught the last fish.

Although fishing was slow the first two days it improved as the tournament went on. Alan Molle tipped Day 3's first sail. High point angler for that day was Fred Schulzke with 150 points. Richard Ziegler caught the last fish of the day.

By the end of day 3 Alan Molle held a slim lead for overall first place. However, many more sailfish were sighted, baited and lost. Final standings would depend on the last day's fishing.

Day 4 was filled with anticipation. A good score and luck could propel anyone into first place. Craig Cohen caught the first fish of the day and Suzzette Cohen caught the last fish of the 2007 tournament.

Trish Bothmer set a personal best by catching an estimated 200-pound marlin, on 20-pound test tournament line. GREAT catch Trish!

Alan Molle's skill and luck outlasted all other anglers. His score of 3 additional sails (450 points) ended all speculation as who would be the Tournament Champion.

The only questions remaining were 2nd, 3rd and 4th place finishers, thereby qualifying for the IGFA Offshore Championship for 2008.

Linda Veninga and her cadre of help not only did a stupendous job of scorekeeping but also did it with secrecy. The final results were not revealed until the awards banquet. Thank you Linda and all who helped.

RICHARD SCHWAGER WINS 20TH EASTCAPE

The 20th Anniversary East-cape Billfish Tournament was held at Hotel Palmas de Cortez, Los Barriles, Baja California Sur, Mexico June 14-18, 2007.

Thirty members of Tournament Anglers Association (TAA) caught and released 27 striped marlin, in three days of competition. In addition, 10 dorado and 1 yellow-fin tuna were boated and enjoyed in the hotel restaurant by the entire group.

While the fish count was down from 2006 (56), 2005 (62) and 2004 (69), there were plenty of marlin to be seen tailing on the surface. The boat captains noted that the water was quite dirty, cold and that the fish seemed to be gorged with squid. Moreover, strong winds came up by mid-morning and very few fish were hooked after noon.

On day 1, Smokey Molle charged to the front with two releases, followed closely by Bruce Main. Considering Smokey's long winning track record, many feared that they would be fighting now for second place. All told, only

8 marlin were released on day one.

The production on day 2 improved slightly to 9 marlin., Led by Bill Evans with two stripers. Smokey managed to hold on to first place with a dorado, for 10 points.

The final day resulted in 10 marlin releases and a new leader and champion, Richard Schwager, of Stockton, California. Richard released two marlin, which when added to his one release on day 2, made him the only three billfish angler for the tournament.

It must be reported that yet another member of the Molle family, grandson Chris, was the high point angler on the last day of the tournament. The good news for the other TAA anglers is that Chris is headed for medical school and will not be a regular threat, at least for a while.

For the second year in a row, the members of the Challenge Division out fished the Champions and each received an Iland lure donated by L & S Bait Company of Florida.

Chairman Dale Miles put on another fabulous show with great trophies, 20th Anniversary Tournament shirts, shorts and hats and many other prizes. Jim Severson and Neal McNamara assisted him. Jim Severson, assisted by Bill Evans, will manage the 2008 Eastcape.
